

Transitional Job Policy

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Transitional Job component is work-based training that provides up to a six month maximum work experience that is wage-paid and subsidized, and is in the public, private, or non-profit section for individuals with barriers to employment.

Barriers to Employment Definition

Barriers to employment are defined as an WIOA adult eligible individual who is disabled or basic skills deficient, or receive TANF services, or an individual who is in a re-entry program from a correctional facility.

Wage-Paid Definition

Wage –paid is defined as a minimum of \$7.25/hour to a maximum of \$12.99 hour. This payment must be equal to wage polices for comparable positions within the worksite.

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
