Resident Assistant Intern

Responsibilities:

- Converses with residents to reinforce positive behaviors and to promote social interaction.
- Transports residents to/from dining areas. Serves meals to residents in the dining area or in their rooms and assists them in eating. Transports residents back to their rooms or to common areas.
- Distributes nutrition supplements, ice, water, etc. as directed by the nursing staff.
- Aids the Therapy and Activities staff with their programs by assisting residents with physical exercises, occupational arts and crafts, and recreational games.
- Observes resident behaviors and notifies appropriate unit personnel of any changes or unusual situations.
